The Minutes of the May 25, 2010 meeting were read with no changes.

Treasurer's Report: Joe Collins. We have \$34,952 revenue year to date and expenses were \$41,800 with balance of assets (including equipment) of \$35,741 which is close to what it was last year at this time. Memberships down around \$2,600 from this time last year.

OFFICE: Mitzi Barnes. We got in 274 applications bringing us to 1112 which is down from last year.. We got in 3 scholarships.

MX: Sheryl Blum. Turnouts have been less than 200 at most events. Dirt Country had 170, Dayton MC 130 and Treaty City had to cancel. Most riders are just practicing and not attending events.

Hare Scramble: Sibyl Hunter. GNCC was first weekend in June. 3 harescrambles in July.

Road/Congress: Mary Hamilton. Finally got one road event completed. Got congress packet today hasn't had a chance to review it yet.

GP: Norm Bickley. GPs are down. Wildwood Lake had 48, Athens 80, Action Sports 145 and not sure how many for Hocking Valley but it was down also. Next GP this coming Saturday.

Hill Climb: Ruth Hughes Hillclimb went well last weekend. Next Hillclimb is July 24 & 25. .

Dirt Track: Art Pickelheimer The event the first weekend in June was cancelled. Lima went well and good crowd. Vintage Week coming up.

ATV Congress: Bill Knaepfner . The rulebook has been split into Road book and recreation book and has been submitted to AMA congress.

Off Road Congress: Dan Knecht got his off road packet. Proposals have to be in by August 6. If anyone has any changes for MX need to get them to him.

Newsletter. Jayne Chrystal. News letter ready to go. The number of ads is down and only have a few stories. Do we want to send this issue out to current and previous members since Thrills in the Hills ad will be in there? Mary made a motion to send out to all current members 2009 and 2010 and print an extra 1000 for shops. Dennis 2<sup>nd</sup>. 11 in favor 2 opposed. Jayne would also like for Joe to take care of paying for postage for newsletter when it is time to send it out due to the difficulty of getting check until last minute. Dennis made motion that Joe take care of paying for newsletter. 2<sup>nd</sup> by Mary. 7 in favor 0 opposed.

Website: Jayne has been working on getting cancellations on as soon as possible..

Old Business: Thrills in the Hills. Norm and Shawna have agreed to have the event at their track as long as they get to run it as they do for their own events with their staff. 60/40 split like last year. Norm suggest having a road bike show or event so road could be more involved in Thrills. Much discussion. Norm will see what he can set up. We would have to do a road charter and pay for more insurance. Dennis said we could do the sanction thru Dayton MC since they already have a road charter. Then we would only have to pay \$150.00 for insurance. We would start it at Moose Lodge. Riders would pay at start and get a wrist band that will get them in when they reach Fast Traxx. Shawna will take care of plaques and Tshirts. It has been requested that Hill Climb send volunteers to help with Thrills in the Hills.

New Business: The 3 scholarships we received will be reviewed by 3 or 4 officers after the meeting.

Fast Traxx is having a ride for Ryan Early at their track. Dynamic Promotions will be owned and operated by Fast Traxx. Norm's kids will be the owners of that track.

Les announced there is a new Hillclimb scheduled for Aug 28 & Aug 29.

Next Harescramble at Athens MC will be 2 hr for bikes and 2 hr for quads. It is being held at a new place on 550 past Amesville
